2. The application form should be duly filled in and send to the principal along with the required documents enumerated below.

#### **ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA**

To be eligible to apply for the DMLT course, the candidate must:

- 1. Have passed Plus Two science or equivalent examination with Physics, Chemistry and biology as subjects.
- **2.** Have completed 17 years of age or not older than 27 years on or before 31.12.2021. The upper age limit is relaxable by 5(five) years for SC/ST candidates and 3(Three) years for OBC candidates.

### **SUBMISSION OF APPLICATION**

- 1. Candidates are required to submit their application along with the required documents completed in all respect to the Principal, St. John's College of Paramedical Sciences, St. John's Hospital campus, Kattappana 685 515 so as to reach on or before 15.09.2021
- 2. The Envelope containing application form shall be prominently super scribed "Application for Admission to DMLT course 2021-2023".
- 3. Application form must be filledin by the candidate's own handwriting using blue or black ball pen in bold capital letters.

- i. To avoid corrections, a Xerox copy of application form may be used as a rough copy for filling and corrections. Finally, the original copy may be filled up accurately. Corrections if any must be legibly signed by the candidates.
- ii. The signature of the candidates must be in running handwriting but not in capital letters.

- iii. The office of the principal shall have no responsibility for applications that reach late for any reason including postal delay. Such applications shall be summarily rejected and no correspondence or representation in this regard shall be entertained.
- 4. Applications that are incomplete, illegible, incorrectly filled in or not accompanied by the required document shall be summarily rejected.
- 5. DOCUMENTS TO BE FURNISHED BY THE CANDIDATES ALONG WITH THE APPLICATION FORM:

(The required documents should be attached to the application form by a Tag).

- a. A recent passport size photograph.
- b. Self-attested true copy of the pass certificate of 10th or equivalent examination with the date of birth of the candidate recorded therein.
- c. Self-attested true copy of the pass certificate& Mark list of the qualifying examination ie +2 Sciences or its equivalent, showing the subjects studied.
- d. Self-attested true copy of the Conduct & character certificate from the Principal of the School/College.
- e. Self-attested true copy of OBC or SC/ST/PH certificate if age relaxation is claimed.

#### 6. **SELECTION**:

- Selection for admission shall be made on the basis of merit list prepared.
  According to the total marks secured in Physics, Chemistry & Biology in the qualifying examination. In case of a tie, the tie will be resolved in following order.
  - a. marks secured in Biology b. as per the date of birth (the older will get preference over the younger)
- 2. Merit lists of the candidates for DMLT courses shall be published on the notice boards of the Offices of Principals and a call letter will be sent by post/E-Mail to attend the counseling.
- 3. Allotment of seats to the candidates shall be made through counseling i.e personal appearance, taking into account the candidates merit and performance etc...
- 4. Counseling will be conducted at the office of the Director, St. John's College of Paramedical Science, and Kattappana.

## 7. ADMISSION:

- 1. A selected candidate shall be required to produce the following documents at the time of counseling failing which the candidature for admission will be cancelled.
  - a. All original documents of the self-attested copies submitted.
  - b. Declaration to the effect of not undertaking any other course simultaneously.

**c.** All the fees are to be paid in 7 days from the date of confirmation of admission and an Affidavit in Rs.500/- Stamp paper should be submitted in connection with the upward revision in fee by the Govt/Court from time to time.
